5. Environmental Goals and Actions

Dehnco does not manufacture or directly distribute/touch our products. Dehnco works with a primary manufacturing partner (Calstone) and **Dehnco is classified as a Wholesaler of Industrial Furniture.**

- ➤ In alignment with the Greenhouse Gas Protocol (GHG-P) Corporate Standard, our goal is to reduce our Scope 1 and 2 greenhouse gases 30% by 2030.
- ➤ We have made Dehnco's commitment to Net Zero by 2050 public through the SME Climate Hub.

The following **ACTIONS** guide Dehnco's environmental goals for responsible environmental protection:

Energy

Dehnco reduces the carbon footprint of its physical office by:

- Reducing energy consumption in the building through the use of smart thermometers, LED lighting, and light timers
- Pursuing cleaner sources for electricity and/or participating in a Power Purchasing Agreement (PPA), as available
- Engaging only with manufacturers who partake in environmentally sound manufacturing practices

Waste Reduction


Dehnco reduces its impact on the environment through the reduction, reuse and recycling of its waste by:

- Minimizing our printing/paper use
- Providing recycling opportunities for paper, plastic, aluminum, and glass products to minimize waste
- Re-using of recycled raw materials, food packaging, and packaging, as appropriate

Water

Dehnco reduces its water usage and thereby reduces water stress in its community by:

- Ensuring taps and toilets in our offices are "low-flow" models
- Only turning on water as necessary for personal hygiene
